Stephanie Radu, Museum Curator provides an update on the Beachville Museum regarding grounds and building maintenance, collections management and research as well as various upcoming activities.

Ms. Radu notes the Township has identified a goal on their strategic plan to attempt to get artifacts into local schools for students to utilize. Ms. Radu notes that the museum has applied to the YCW-BCW internship program for funding that would facilitate the hire of an Educational Coordinator (EC). The EC would work from June through October of 2019 to develop educational units and activities, network with local school teachers and school board officials as well as other museum colleagues. He/she would design lesson plans, study guides and other resources for teachers and would be charged with reinvigorating the museum's educational outreach program. We are still awaiting the results for this grant as YCW cites administrative delays.
