Presentation of Report

Meghan House of the County of Oxford Community Planning Office reviews the planning report for the Committee pertaining to property described as Part of Lot 20, Concession 1 (North Dorchester, previously North Oxford), in the Township of Zorra. The subject lands located on the west side of Banner Road (15th Line), between Road 68 (Oxford Road 2) and Road 66, and are municipally known as 154889 15th Line in the Village of Thamesford..

The proposed draft plan of subdivision consists of 199 lots for single detached dwellings and a park block on four new public roads, including extensions of Linda Lane and Sloan Drive, in the Village of Thamesford.

The application for Official Plan Amendment proposes to re-designate the subject lands to ‘Low Density Residential’ and ‘Open Space’ and proposes a waiver of the requirement for completion of a Secondary Plan in accordance with Section 4.2.2.4 of the Official Plan.

The application for Zoning By-law Amendment proposes to rezone the subject lands from ‘Development Zone (D)’ to ‘Special Residential Type 1 Zone (R1-28 (H))’, with site specific provisions to permit reduced minimum lot frontage, front yard depth, and exterior side yard width and increased maximum lot coverage, as well as ‘Holding (H)’ provisions prohibiting any residential development until such time as the adjacent Banner Pit (Licence No. 611821) ceases operation and is rehabilitated as per the requirements of the Aggregate Resources Act, and ‘Recreational Zone (REC)’ for the proposed park block.

Ms. House notes that at the time of writing the report one comment was received from a nearby property owner regarding concern with the form of the development being all single family homes, rather than providing a mix of housing types. Specially, the resident indicated that there is a lack of housing that is appropriate for seniors in the Thamesford area.

Mr. Frijia, Applicant is in attendance and notes their intent is to get servicing drawings approved in 2020, begin servicing Phase 1 in 2021 and potentially building homes in early 2022.

Council Question Period

Councillor Davies questions why the applicant is requesting to increase the maximum lot coverage to 40%. Ms. House notes that these are special provisions that have been requested and are currently in place in the existing Thames Springs East development.

Mayor Ryan questions the opportunities for any area of the development to have medium density at this stage in the process. Ms. House notes that there are always opportunities to have further density where it is appropriate, however in this case it has not been contemplated in the comprehensive review numbers and higher density will be built on the Maple Leaf lands, therefore the County did not feel it was necessary on this site.
