## Zorra COVID-19 Update #10

### NEWS

Please be advised that all playground equipment is now closed and off limits for use. However, public parks are still open and residents may use the parks provided physical distancing is practiced. Please be respectful and help stop the spread of COVID-19;

- Wash your hands with soap and water thoroughly and often.
- Cough and sneeze into your sleeve or a tissue.
- Dispose of tissue immediately and wash your hands.
- Keep surfaces clean and disinfected.
- Practice physical distancing by staying at least 2 metres apart.
- Stay home when you are sick.

The Township will continue to seek guidance from Southwestern Public Health on whether parks and open space areas should be open to the public. We understand some jurisdictions have closed parks, however, at this time we feel that as long as residents practice physical distancing the benefits of physical exercise and fresh air are important for the mental well-being of our community. If you use our parks, please practice physical distancing and do your part in helping stop the spread of COVID-19.
