Do you have a dog?

All dogs over 3 months of age are required to be registered with the Township. Pick up your tag at the Township office or complete the form on our website. Each tag has an annual fee of \$15.00 and this can be paid at the office or added to your tax bill.



Zorra Township is a rural municipality located at the north-west corner of Oxford County. The Township is comprised of several rural clusters and two serviced villages (Embros and Thamesford). The population of Zorra Township is 8,138, with a total land area of 529 square kilometres. Our Municipal Council is made up of a Mayor and four Ward Councillors.

What about taxes?

We have many options available for payment of property taxes. Installments are four times per year in February, May, August, and October. Setup pre-authorized payment from your bank account! Open Air Burning

If you are in a rural property, you may find the need to have an occasional controlled burn to get rid of brush, etc. A permit is required. The application form is available on our website and must be approved by the Fire Chief before you can burn. Plan ahead! Garbage and Recycling

Waste Management is managed by the County of Oxford. Curbside collection of garbage and recycling is every Monday morning in Zorra Township. Have your items to the curb by 7am on collection day. Garbage bags cost \$2.00 each and can be purchased at various locations throughout the Township, including the Township Office. You can also purchase the following items at our office (based on availability):

- Blue Boxes \$5.50 each
- Mini blue boxes \$3.50 each
- Above Ground Composter \$10.00
- Green Cone Food Digester \$40.00
- Rain Barrel \$45.00

Free large article pickup occurs every spring. There are also several Special Collection Events throughout the County each year. Watch the Waste Management calendar for details - it is delivered to your mailbox each fall.
