

ZORRA MARCH BREAK DAY CAMP FAQ

Below you will find general information on the most common questions asked regarding Zorra's March Break Day Camp. If you have any additional question that can't be answered below, please email Stephanie at sstarchuck@zorra.on.ca.

DATES, TIMES & LOCATION

Camp hours will be from 9am to 4:00pm, with drop off starting at 8:30am and pick ending at 4:30pm.

Before and after care is available from 7:30am-8:30am and 4:30pm-5:30pm at an additional cost of \$20.00/week or \$4.00/day for each before or after care time.

Camp will start each day with parent sign in at the Small Hall in the Embro Community Centre. Pick up will occur at the same location as drop off and will also require a parent or guardian to sign out.

COSTS

Registration fees are \$160.00 per child per week or \$35.00 per child each day. Refunds will be issued up until 15 days from the start of camp and subject to an administration fee.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

Camp will be accepting children who will be 4 years old on their first day of camp and not older than 10 years old on or before December 31st, 2019.
