

Public Skating Rules

Please read and abide by all posted rules and cooperate with arena staff:

- Ice skate required – No street shoes
- Helmets are strongly recommended
- No strollers, hockey sticks and pucks during public skating sessions
- Do not carry children or items while skating
- Before entering the ice surface, look for oncoming skaters
- Maintain control of your speed, course of direction and do not stop where you will obstruct other skaters
- Parents/Guardians must be within sight and control of their children. Do not leave children unattended
- Know your abilities and skate within your limits
- Do not throw or leave objects on the ice surface
- No power skating or figure skating during public skating sessions
- Wheelchairs/sledges are permitted for persons who require mobility aids (support persons if present are required to wear skates)
- Please respect your facility
