

COVID-19 Facility Guidelines: Public Skating & Shinny User Protocol



The Township of Zorra remains committed to providing a safe and positive experience for members of the Community at our Public Skating and Shinny programs. Staff will continue to follow guidance issued by Southwestern Public Health and orders from the Province of Ontario. Participants in these recreational drop-in programs are responsible for adhering to this policy.

The Township of Zorra will provide Public Skating and Shinny with the following precautions:

General Precautions:

- A maximum of 25 skaters will be permitted to participate
- Access to the facility is for on-ice participants only.
- When minors are participating, one (1) parent/caregiver is required for supervision.
- For this purpose, a minor is an individual under the age of 14.
- Parent/caregivers are also included in a 50-person facility capacity.
- All visitors over the age of 2 are required to wear a face covering unless engaged in on-ice physical activities or are exempt for medical reasons.
- Maintain 2 metres physical distance from members of other households.
- Wash hands or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer frequently.
- Do not enter the facility if:
 - You have travelled outside Canada in the last 14 days.
 - You have symptoms of COVID-19 or are feeling unwell.
 - Someone in your household has COVID-19 symptoms or has been exposed to someone who has or is recovering from COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- Come ready to play. Change rooms will not be available prior to skating. The lobby will be available to put on skates.
- For contact tracing, all visitors will be asked to provide their contact information. This information will be kept in a secure location at the facility.
- Participants will be permitted to enter the lobby 15 minutes before the program.
- The main entrance will remain locked 15 minutes after the program begins or when the program reaches capacity.
- Once the program begins, the lobby will be cleared of all participants/visitors and belongings to allow for cleaning by arena staff.
- Following their ice time, groups are asked to promptly leave the ice surface, collect their belongings, and proceed through the marked exit to an assigned changeroom(s).
- Users have 15 minutes from the end of the program to exit the facility.
