Last month I presented to the Ontario Government's Standing Committee on Heritage, Infrastructure, and Culture Policy for their review of Regional Governments. I think government services should always be delivered at the smallest, most local level that they can be, and only larger when it is a larger service, or genuinely saves money. I highlighted that in Oxford we get the benefits of small accountable local municipal governments and the economies of scale of a larger regional municipal government by dividing services accordingly.

- Zorra recreation, fire, police, building, transit, local roads
- Oxford water & wastewater, garbage & recycling, long term care, ambulance, land use planning, housing and human services, regional roads

And over the last few days myself, Deputy Mayor Grigg, and Councillor Finch attended the Association of Municipalities Conference in Ottawa. I had good conversations with the Solicitor General, Minister of Energy, Minister of Education, and many others about the issues we need provincial collaboration on. First and foremost being that municipal services and expectations have changed, but funding has not. Your property taxes were never intended to address social services like mental health, addiction, and homelessness. The province needs to do their part, and fund municipalities for what we're already doing. Residents of Zorra and Oxford are doing MORE than their part already.
