RECOMMENDATION:

That Report 2023-124 and the 2024 Budget Survey Responses be received as information.

BACKGROUND & COMMENTS:

The Township participated in the County wide Budget Consultation Online Survey which began in June and ran through to the end of August. It was promoted through the Township and County websites, the Township's social media platforms, local media and tax bill inserts.

Meaningful and effective public engagement improves the quality of decisions made, facilitates citizen understanding of issues and government process, fosters respect for the views of others and increases support, understanding and ownership of decisions made.

There were 163 responses received of Zorra Township, an increase of 288% from the last survey conducted in 2021 to inform the 2022 Budget. The full results of the survey are attached for Council's information.

The survey illustrated how property taxes were spent in 2023 and asked residents to indicate whether the same services should be enhanced, maintained or reduced in the upcoming year. The large majority of responses want to see all services maintained at current levels. When asked about the overall value received from the Township's tax dollars, 73.5% of the respondents rated it Fair to Good. (page 20 of 28 of the budget survey document)

Residents were asked to identify their top three priorities in their community. The most common options chosen were (page 21 of 28 of the budget survey document):

- Safe Communities-Police Services 36
- Active living Parks & Trails 35
- Affordable Housing 35
- Active Living -Recreation 25
- Infrastructure Roads & Bridges 23

Respondents who submitted comments through the 2024 Budget Survey are provided as part of this report. Reference Schedule A attached.



FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

There is no direct financial impact to the current budget; however, survey results referenced in the report will be considered in determining the 2024 budget and tax levy.
