



ZORRA MARCH BREAK DAY CAMP FAQ

Below you will find general information on the most common questions asked regarding Zorra's March Break Day Camp. If you have any additional question that can't be answered below, please email us at zorracamp@zorra.ca.

DATES, TIMES & LOCATION

Camp hours will be from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., with drop off starting at 8:00 a.m. and pick ending at 5:30 p.m.

Before and after care is available from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. at an additional cost of \$30.00/week or \$6.00/day for each before or after care time.

Camp will start each day with parent sign in at the Small Hall in the Embro-Zorra Community Centre. Pick up will occur at the same location as drop off and will also require a parent or guardian to present photo ID in order to sign out their child.

COSTS

Registration fees are \$164.00 per child per week or \$40.00 per child each day. Refunds one week before the start of camp will be honoured. Cancellations within the week before the start of camp will be subject to a \$50 cancellation fee. Cancellations due to illness and injury are permitted, subject to a doctors note.

ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

Camp will be accepting children who will be 4 years old on their first day of camp and not older than 11 years old on or before December 31, 2023.

Please be aware that registration must be paid in full for your child's spot to be confirmed at Camp.

WAITLISTS

Should the week of camp you require be full at time of registration, please utilize the waitlist! We are often able to add campers from the waitlist to the camp once we can determine that our staffing ratios can be met.

STANDARD DAY AT CAMP

Campers can expect days full of fun and excitement! A typical day will include activities on the ice, outdoor activities, games, crafts, and more! A more detailed calendar included in our Welcome Package will be provided as we near the start of camp.

As we will be including skating into our activities on some days, campers must wear skates and a CSA-approved helmet to participate. Additionally, we will also be going outside most days and campers should come prepared with the proper outdoor clothing.

Meal and snack breaks will occur throughout the day and participants are required to bring a bagged lunch. A refrigerator will be available to keep lunches cold, if necessary.
